ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Interested bidders must submit the following documents:

- (i) Certificate of Incorporation issued by Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC) including Forms CAC2 and CAC7 for firms/companies;
- (ii) Company's current Tax Clearance Certificate for the last three (3) years valid till 31 st December 2021.
- (iii) Verifiable documentary evidence of at least three (3) similar jobs executed in the last few years.
